


August 2022, Samsun, Turkey











INTRODUCTION:

Our Project, starting in 2019, NO TO VIOLENCE AND DISCRIMINATION was carried out with the partnership of Turkey, Greece, Italy and Romania, with Poland being the cordinating country. With the scope of the project, we prepared a survey which 340 male and 223 female students participated in.(24 students did not specify gender) 94 students from Turkey, 126 from Romania, 44 from Greece, 122 from Italy and 214 from Poland participated in the survey.

The results of the questionnaire we applied to the students are given in the below report.


The main topic of our survey is whether there is bulliying in their schools or not. ERASMUS+

PERSONAL DATA:

HOW MANY MALE AND FEMALE STUDENTS PARTICIPATED IN THE SURVEY?

From 5 countries, 340male and 223 female students took place in the survey(24 students did not specify gender). Most of the students answering the questions are male.



HOW OLD ARE YOU?

47 students are between 19-20 years old

99 students are between 18-19 years old

132 students are between 17-18 years old






166 students are between 16-17 years old

48 students are between 15-16 years old

78 students are between 14-15 years old

17 students are between 13-14 years old

Most of the students participating in the survey is above 17 years old and few of them are below 15 years old.



GENERAL INFORMATION:

HOW DOES YOUR SCHOOL FIGHT BULLIYING?

- 42 of the students participating in the survey talk to the school guidance teacher.
- 44 of the students participating in the survey speak to the police officers.
- 5 of the students participating in the survey wtite their problem in THE BLUE BOX in their schools.






359 of the students participating in the survey think that their schools dont do anything about bulliying.

- 37 of the students think that private lessons are prepared in their schools.
- 11 of the students say that they have no idea what their schools do about bullying.
- 62 of the students say that they know what their schools do about bulliying.

According to the data above, we get the impression that most of the students from five countries believe that they are bullied somehow .However ,authorities in their schools don't bother to take any precautions to stop this. As a matter of fact ,they don't feel safe ,maybe they feel alone and vulnerable. We see that as a result of the survey ,bullying is a big problem in each country. Even if school management is aware of it ,they don't react as expected.



HOW DO YOU REACT IN SUCH SITIUATIONS?


- 44 of the students inform the students.
- 57 of the students say that they help the students who are bullied.
- 22 of the students say that they have never seen any bulliying.
- 144 of the students say they have never lived such a situation.
- 128 of the students say that they sometimes meet such a situation.
- 5 of the students say that they share this problem with their friends.
- 71 of the students say that they meet such a situation every day.





1 of the students say that he isnt sure whether there is a situation like this or not.

According to data above ,unfortunately nearly 60 % of the students meet such a situation, and try to find a way to help the student bullied.




DO YOU KNOW ANY INSTITUTION IN YOUR AREA YOU CAN INFORM ABOUT BULLIYING?

- 62 of the students say yes.
- 42 of the students talk with school counselor.
- 37 of the students say that special lessons are prepared.
- 33 of the students prefer not to say.
- 359 of the students say no.
- 44 of the students say that they meet with the students.
- 5 of the students say that they write their problems into the blue box in their schools.





According to tha data we got from the survey,unfortunately, more than half of the students participating in the survey don't know where to apply for when they are bullied. Very few of them share it with either their friends or school counselor. Few of them know where to apply for when bullied.



SAFETY AT SCHOOL:

SAY BULLIYING IS A PROBLEM IN OUR COMMUNITIES:

201 of the students strongly agree with this.

42 of the students strongly disagree with this.

189 of the students agree with this.

118 of the students disagree with this.


4 of the students dont agree with it at all.

34 of the students are neutral.

Almost 80% of the students participating in the survey agree that bullying is aproblem in their communities. Therefore, that shows us that we need to accept that bulliying is one of the biggest problems of our schools.







DO YOU FEEL SAFE AT SCHOOL?

102 of the students sometimes feel safe at school.

182 of the students say that they often feel safe at school.

24 of the students say that they never feel safe at school.


3 of the students say that they dont feel safe at school.

277 of the students say that they always feel safe at school.

According to the data above, nearly 90% of the students feel safe at school, but almost 10 of the students don't feel sfe at school. That is a pleasant result for us.







DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR HAVE YOU EVER WITNESSED BULLYING IN YOUR SCHOOL?

202 of the students say that they have always witnessed bullying in their schools.

4 of the students say that they dont witness any bullying.

27 of the students say that they have never witnessed bulliying in their schools.

32 of the students say that they dont know.

154 of the students say thay they have often witnessed bulliying in thir schools.


73 of the students say that they have often witnessed bulliying in their school.

50 of the students say that they have witnessed bullying in their school.

Unfortunately, we should admit that nearly 90% of the students have witnessed bullying in their schools. That result shows us that we absolutely should admit that bullying is a problem which shouldn't be ignored and neglected, so all the measures should immediately be taken against it.







PREVENTION:

WHAT DOES YOUR SCHOOL DO ABOUT THIS SITIUATION?


168 of the students think that students bullying others must be punished severely

218 of the students say that parents must be alarmed about the situation.

According to the results, most of the students think that parents must be alarmed about the situation in a way by giving detailed and more informative lectures about the topic. Furthermore, severe punishments must be given to deter the students from bullying.

WHAT COULD BE DONE IN YOUR SCHOOL TO IMPROVE THE SITUATION?


116 of the students think that severe punishments must be given.

161 of the students think that victims must meet experts.


67 of the students think that extra lessons must be given about the topic.

In oredr to improve this situation, more severe punishments should be taken, such as expelled from the school .And ,also more students must be informed by the experts.

SUMMARY;

According to the results which we got from the survey, most of the students strongly believe that there is a bullying problem in their schools. Nevertheless, few precautions are taken to prevent students who are bullied, such as some punishments, expelled from schools. On the scope of survey, we get the impression that school counsellors are not sufficient enough to stop bullying at schools. Therefore, students believe that some extra lessons must be given to deter students from bullying. In the light of this search we understand that students must meet police officers to get the accurate information about what they should do if thy meet any situitions about bulliying. More conferences must be organized at schhols by police officers. Students who are bullied must be couraged to hare their problems with their friends, school counsellors and their families. Families must be alerted about bullying and consequently giving more informative seminars to the parents could be helpful and useful. We should courage the students bullied not to stay quiet. We should let them know that being bullied is not their fault and they are not victims and they are not alone.





Last but not least, BLUE BOXES must be used at schools, since students can't express their feelings freely, it could be a good idea for students to write their problems anonymously into blue boxes ,and in other words ,we can learn the problems of bullied students and in this way we can help them. We all hope to live in a World where there is no violence ,no bulliying and no discrimination.
